## SARSEN TRAIL & NEOLITHIC MARATHON

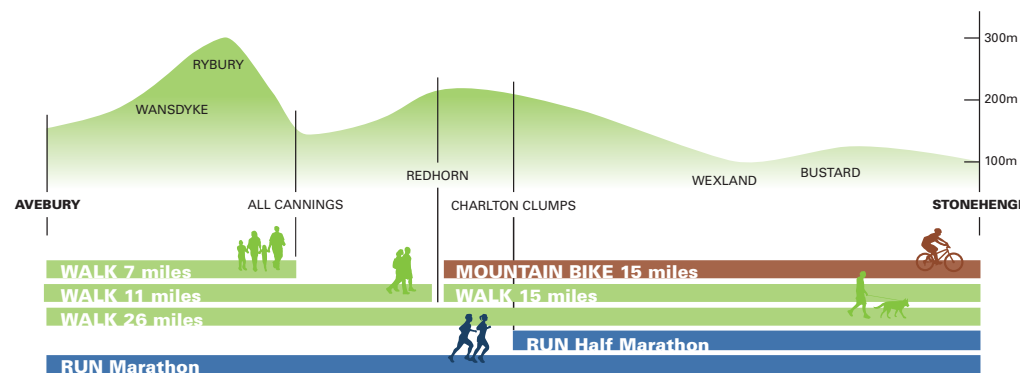
WALK, RUN or CYCLE through the heart of Wiltshire
